RIMS customers will be able to easily comply with the requirements of leading retailers and the Department of Defense.

Additionally, Robocom is currently working with several customers to define requirements to incorporate vendor-applied or RIMS-created RFID tags with RIMS functionality. This will allow RIMS warehouses to read ePCs during receiving, shipment validation, etc.
